Identity at the Center

Access decisions begin with a real-time understanding of the person, location and time. Identity must persist across systems, roles and environments.



Who

HID physical access control system (PACS) platforms authenticate individuals through unified credentials linked to unique digital identities.



Where

Location-specific permissions allow context-aware access across campuses, buildings and zones.



When

Time-bound rules support schedules, shifts and temporary access for roles like contractors.

Credential Flexibility

HID supports multiple physical credentials, including HID Seos cards, mobile access via HID Origo platforms and biometric integrations to meet diverse user needs.

Today's environments demand multiple credential types. Mixed support allows a gradual shift to mobile and biometric integrations without losing continuity or control.

Three Layers of Built-In Security

Security must exist at every touchpoint and layer of the architecture.



Credential: Encrypted, authenticated, revocable credentials support mutual authentication and dynamic encryption.



Device: Tamper detection, secure elements and signed firmware — HID readers and controllers include secure boot and device-level integrity checks.



Cloud: Role-based access, audit logs and secure APIs — HID Origo platforms provide secure multi-tenant cloud services with real-time logging and policy controls.

Central Oversight, Local Responsiveness

Enterprise systems require centralized visibility, but must also function when offline, remote or segmented.



One policy, many sites: Central control panels manage access globally while supporting region-specific rules.



Distributed decisions, unified control: Mercury MP Intelligent Controllers make decisions locally, even if cloud connections drop.

Visibility That Drives Action

Analytics inform decisions. A modern system shows who accessed what, when, and flags anomalies that may indicate risk.



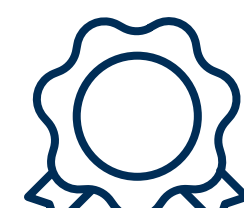
Real-time data

Open standards: OSDP, REST APIs and SIA DC-09 enable integration with third-party systems.
